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Covid-19 - Behaviour principles

In light of the need for children to behave differently when they return to school, there are some changes to our behaviour policy.

- Pupils will need to carefully follow their group's routines for arrival and departure
 - This includes not mixing with children from other groups and maintaining social distance in line with government guidelines
 - Pupils need to arrive within their allocated time slot
 - Pupils need to leave promptly and ensure their behaviour before and after school is consistent with government guidelines
- Pupils will need to follow school instructions on hygiene
 - They will regularly wash their hands for 20 seconds and must do so when asked
 - Pupils will use the wipes provided to keep their own area and equipment clean
 - Pupils will contribute to keeping their group areas tidy
- Pupils will need to following instructions on who they can socialise with at school
 - Pupils will need to stay within their bubbles and not mix with people from other bubbles
 - Pupils need to give each other space
 - Pupils need to follow staff instructions to give each other space promptly
- When moving around the school pupils must follow the systems which are in place including
 - The one-way system
 - Space out markings
 - Using designated travel zones outside
 - Sticking to outside zone as instructed
 - Using space out markings when queuing

- Use follow your buddy system to move as a group
 - Stop and Check at doorways
 - Give staff and other pupils space
- Pupils need to do their best to follow expectations about sneezing, coughing, tissues and disposal ('catch it, bin it, kill it') and avoiding touching their mouth, nose and eyes with hands
- Pupils must tell an adult if they are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus
- Pupils have their own pack of equipment
 - They must look after this and will not share
 - Equipment is not shared unless authorised by the headteacher where an appropriate cleaning routine is in place
- Pupils will not bring things to school unless essential and agreed with their teacher
 - Water bottles will be washed on arrival and must stay in school; they will be clearly named and cannot be shared
 - If packed lunch is required it will be in a disposable bag
- During break times, pupils will be able to play
 - They must stay in the zone
 - They will stay within their protective bubble
 - Games will allow pupils to give each other space
 - They have their own equipment
- Pupils will be allowed to use the toilets throughout the day
 - No more than '2 in the Loo'
 - Stop and Check before entering
 - Use space markers to 'Q to P'
- Pupils must behave in a safe way
 - Follow guidelines and instructions
 - Do not cough or spit at or towards any other person
- Pupils at home are expected to do their best with the home learning and ensure they are safe and kind when online
- Pupils unable or unwilling to follow protective measures will not be able to attend school pending the completion of a risk assessment showing reasonable control measures which will ensure expectations are met
