
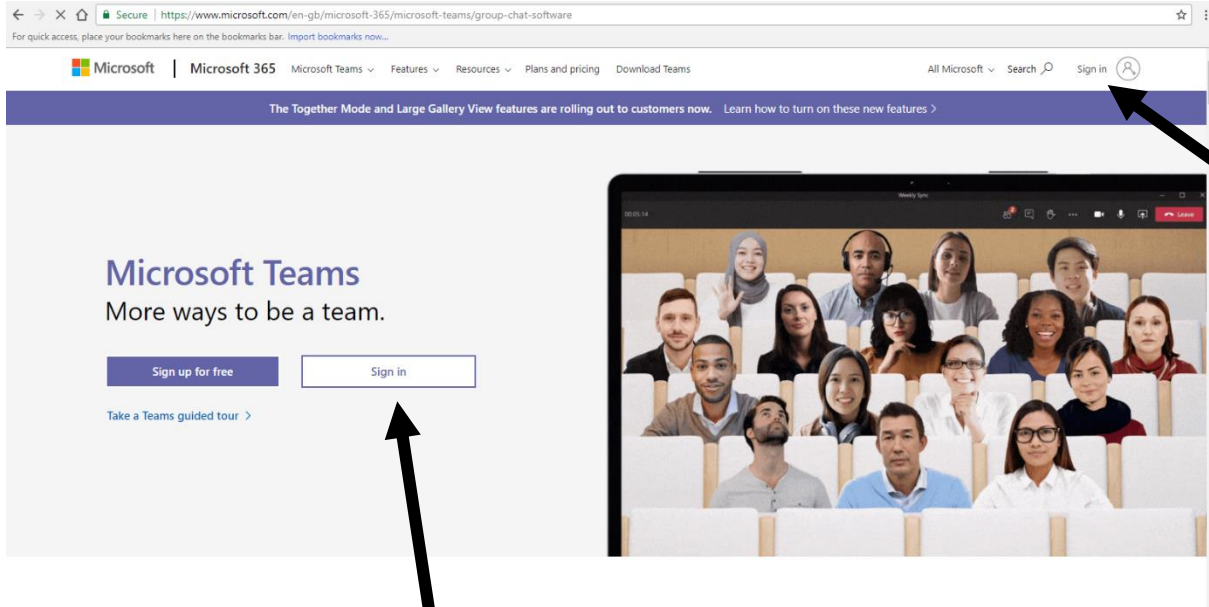


## How to access your Teams classroom

1. Once you have opened an internet browser, for example Google Chrome  search for **Microsoft Teams**. Select the first option which is available. Once you have clicked on it, it should open to the window below:

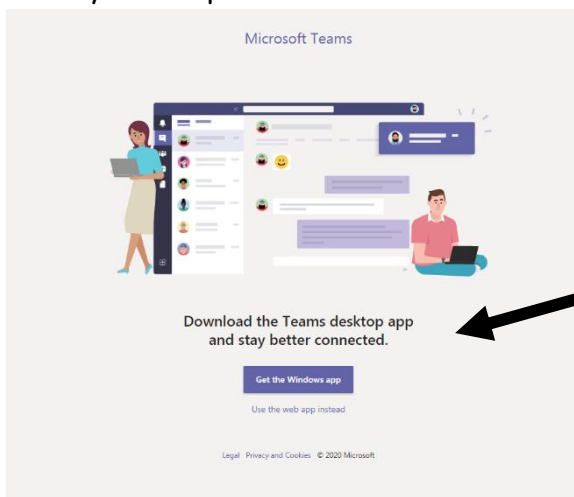


2. Your child has their own sign in for **Microsoft Teams**. Their login is the year they have started in Year 3, their first initial, and then their surname. Your child will know their password.

It will look something like this:

**Username:** 20EBoyd      **Password:** bordonjun

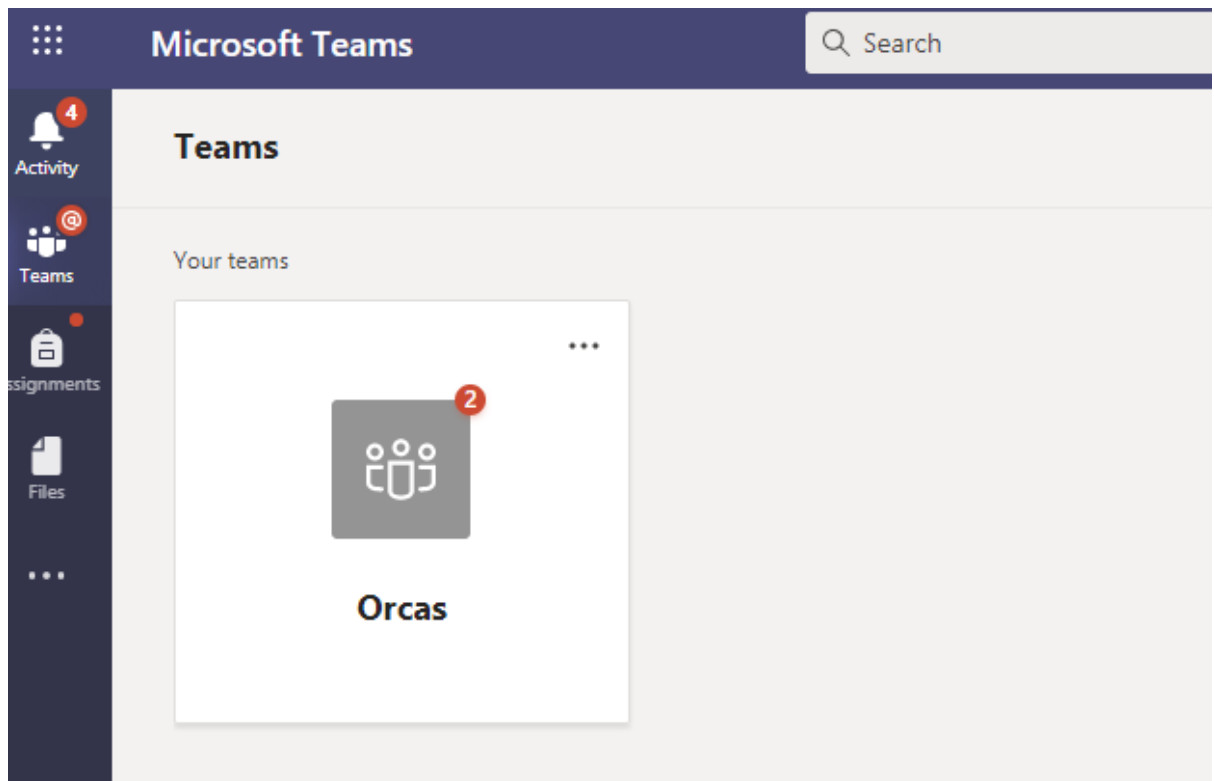
3. It may come up with this screen:



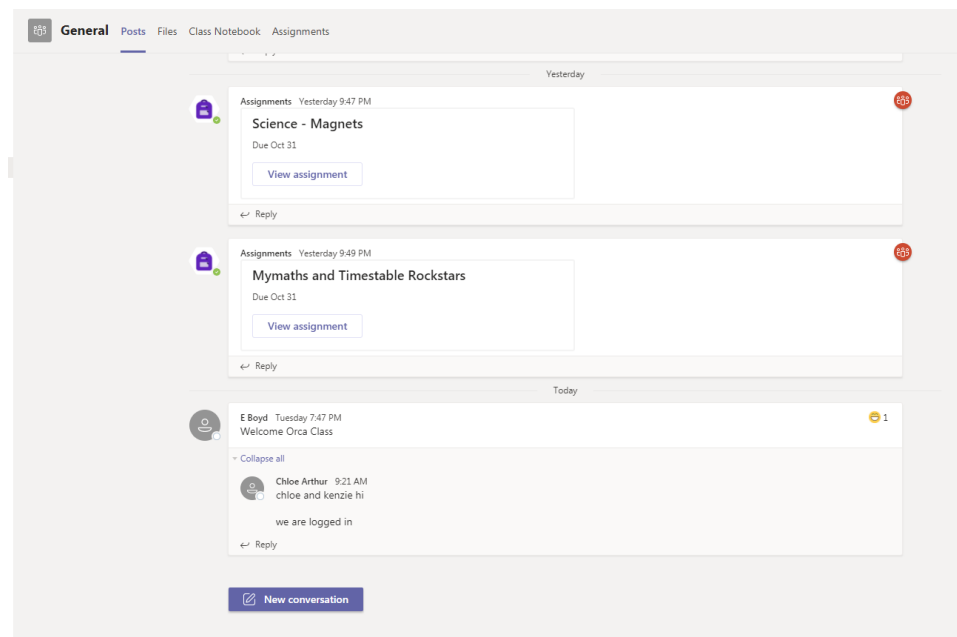
You can either:

- 2) Use the web app instead.

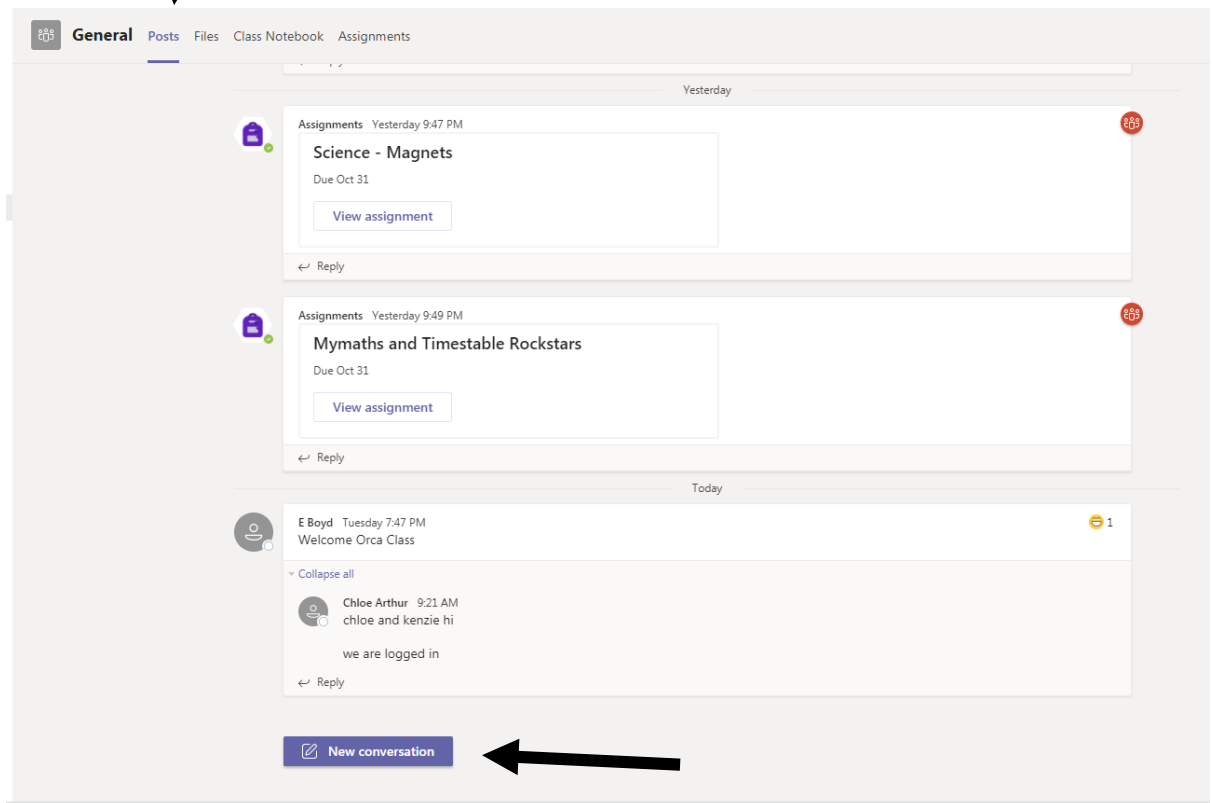
4. This will then take you directly to your **Microsoft Teams** page. Your child will have been entered into a **class page** which will look something like this:



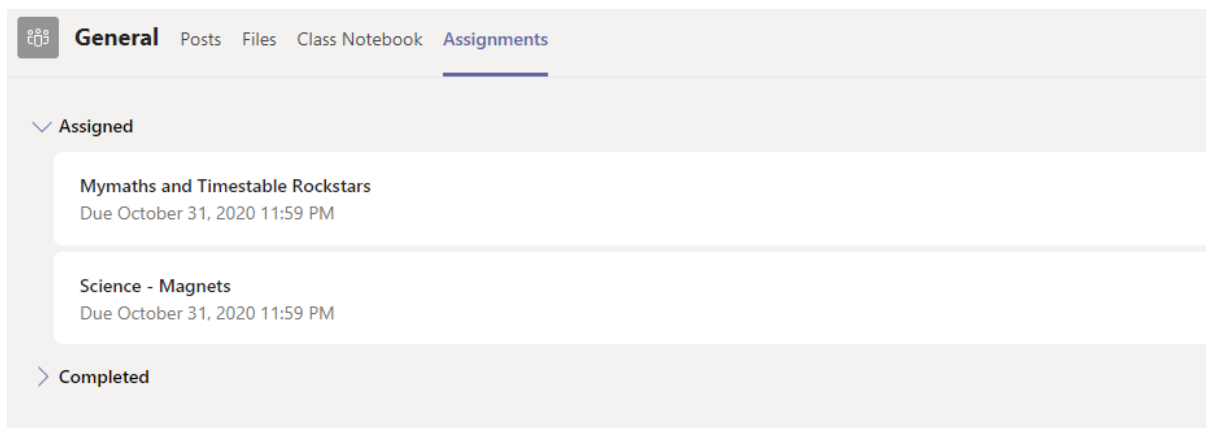
5. Within your **class page**, you will be able to find assignments and posts.
